We would like to confirm that the shipment from Iowa City will be delayed by one week and ready on May 11th. As per our current calculations there are 354 cubic feet of goods in the shipment. The cubic feet is based upon the recommendation of an art packer that each item float in 6 inches of shock absorbing materials. I am waiting to receive the estimate of the total packed weight from the packers in Iowa - which should be given to me tomorrow. The weight of the equipment and five crates we already have is 1,768 lbs. In Iowa City they are calculating the weight of 4 more crates plus all of the packing materials (plastic, foam, cardboard, styrofoam "peanuts"). Following is our updated information on dimensions and Insurance Replacement Values. Please be assured you will have the total weight as quickly as I do. We are doing all that is possible as quickly as possible. As you know we must depend on others to get back to us.

The loan forms can be signed by ARS ELECTRONICA, but first should be filled by each lender or by the Vasulkas. Then please send us the forms and we'll sign them. The only thing which still is not clear is the date of transportation. Brigitte Vasicek, who is organizing all transportation, insurance and customs matters, says, that we can delay the transport one week, if she receives all exact datas on the machines we have asked you for before.
